

FNB SWIPE AND WIN 2024 - COMPETITION RULES

Read these competition rules carefully. These competition rules ("rules") explain your rights and duties under this competition. Promoter(s) Name(s):	The promoter of this competition is FNB Namibia Limited. FNB refers to First National Bank of Namibia Limited, a division of FirstRand Namibia Limited with Reg. No. 2002/0180. In these rules, we refer to the above promoter(s) as "the promoter(s)". We refer to participants and winners as "you".
Entries open and close:	Entries open at 8h00 on 1 August 2024 and close at 23h59 on 30 November 2024. The promoter(s) reserves the right to extend the competition. Notice of this will be posted on FNB's website.
Who cannot take part?	The following persons may not take part in this competition even if they qualify to take part. They will forfeit (give up) any prizes awarded to them: a) Any director, member, partner, agent, or consultant of the promoter(s). b) Any other person who directly or indirectly controls the promoter(s). c) The spouse, life partner, siblings, children, or parents of any of the persons named in a, b, or c.
How to enter and qualifying criteria? GENERAL RULES THAT APPLY
