

## FNB "Future Account Competition" – COMPETITION RULES

Read these competition rules carefully. These competition rules ("rules") explain your rights and duties under this competition. If you take part in this competition or accept any prize, these rules will apply to you, and you agree that the person running the competition ("the promoter/s") can assume that you have read and agreed to be legally bound by these competition rules.

Promoter(s) Name(s):	The promoters of this competition are FNB Namibia Limited.  FNB refers to First National Bank of Namibia Limited, a division of FirstRand Namibia Limited with Reg. No. 2002/0180.  In these rules, we refer to the above promoter(s) as "the promoter(s)". We refer to participants and winners as "you".
Entries open and close:	Entries open at 8h00 on 04 March 2025 and will close at 23h59 on 25 March 2025.  The promoter(s) reserves the right to extend the competition.
Who cannot take part?	The following persons may not take part in this competition even if they qualify to take part. They will forfeit (give up) any prizes awarded to them:  a) Any director, member, partner, agent, staff member of, or consultant of the promoter(s).  b) Any other person who directly or indirectly controls the promoter(s).  c) Any employee of the promoter(s).  d) The spouse, life partner, siblings, children, or parents of any of the persons named in a, b, or c.
How to enter and qualifying criteria?	Entry into this competition is automatic for all customers that open a new FNB Future Account between 04 March 2025 and 25 March 2025, activate the account by depositing into your new FNB Future Account (a minimum amount of N\$50 (Fifty Namibian Dollars only)).  Normal account opening procedures prevail – For persons under the age of 16, the parent/guardian must open the account on behalf of the child by presenting their original ID/Passport and child's original full birth certificate. For persons over the age of 16 the account can be opened by the child by presenting original Namibian ID/Passport.
Is there a limit on the number of times you can enter?	One entry per Future account based on meeting criteria above.

## **GENERAL RULES THAT APPLY**
